SCHOOL CONTEXT:

ACSS enrolls 833 students from grades 9 - 12. As a community school, we also partner with Betty Gilbert Middle School (BGMS) to teach Grade 8 Exploration courses (Expos) to 164 students. Therefore, our grade 8–12 total student population is 997 students.

ACSS is a very diverse learning community. Some of the unique distinctions in our population of 833 include: 171 learning designations (21%), 96 self-identify as Indigenous (11.5%), 135 students are part of our International Student Program (ISP) (16%) and 82 are ELL learners (9.8%).
