

LITERACY DATA:



Literacy has been an area of growth at LSS for the last several years. Data has shown that the interventions that have been put in place has been highly effective with our students reading significantly below grade level and has also been impactful in helping our students at grade level demonstrate significant growth in their reading levels as well. The graph above shows data from the same student cohort in Grade 10 and then again in Grade 12 on provincial literacy assessments where they are assessed against provincial benchmarks.
