How we will achieve our goals

- Establish essential skills and curricular competencies at each grade.
- Integrate oral story telling K-5 as it aligns with Indigenous oral story telling traditions
- Embed Story Workshop K-5 to support student language development and writing skills
- Embed Heggerty Pre K and Embed UFLI (K - 2)
- Support students to find 'self' in stories and to make connections to 'self' or the world around them
- Develop common cross grade assessments and language
